Heidsieck & Co. Monopole ‘Gout Americain’

This infamous wine was miraculously recovered from a shipwreck off the coast of Finland, where it sank on 3 November 1916. During the First World War, the Swedish ketch Jonkoping was sunk by a German submarine on its way to St Petersburg, while carrying a special shipment for the Russian Imperial Army. The precious cargo included 10,000 gallons of Cognac, 17 barrels of Burgundy wine and 3000 bottles of Heidsieck & Co Monopole 1907 Gout Americain. In the summer of 1997, the wreck was found by a Swedish search team and lifted to the surface in July 1998. Unfortunately, the Cognac and Burgundy did not survive 82 years under the sea, however 2500 bottles of the Heidsieck & Co Monopole Champagne were extraordinarily preserved. Now Crown is proud to offer a Champagne that is a rare piece of history as well as a fine and complex wine.

Domaine de la Romanée-Conti

The iconic Domaine de la Romanée-Conti is known as France's leading producer of red Burgundy wine. Year on year the Domaine has turned out wines of supreme excellence with a balance of power and finesse that both seduces and excites the senses. Although the vineyard itself may seem non-descript, it is one of the most revered in France with a winemaking history dating back to the thirteenth century. In 1760 it was purchased by Louis-François de Bourgon, Prince de Conti, who renamed it Romanée-Conti, and notoriously kept all the highly prized wine to himself. After the Prince died in exile the vineyard changed hands many times and now belongs to two winemaking families, de Villaine and Roch. The Romanée-Conti vineyard was last replanted in 1946 from Romanée-Conti rootstocks and the first vintage from these vines was 1952. Yields are very low, with around three vines producing one bottle. Made with traditional winemaking techniques and minimal interference, the wines are imbued with balance, poise and refinement. A magical and surreal experience for any winelover.
